It has been decided to revise the number of berths to be earmarked as RAC in Non-LHB coaches of different classes as under:-

2. Zonal Railways will take necessary action to define enhanced RAC berths in the profile of the trains and ensure its booking from ARP or no booking date whichever is earlier. The exercise of defining enhanced RAC accommodation should be completed latest by 15.01.2017 and from 16.01.2017, trains in which booking will be opened should have enhanced RAC accommodation as mentioned above.
